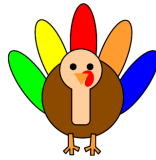

Recipe

Pumpkin Pancakes

4 eggs

1 cup milk

1 cup flour

1 cup canned pumpkin

3 Tbsp. Butter

All Fruit Spread or honey

2 Tbsp. Melted butter

Combine eggs, milk, flour, melted butter and canned pumpkin. Stir until smooth. Let stand for 1 hour. Bake on a well greased griddle or in a skillet where 2-3 tbsp. of butter have been melted. Serve with All Fruit Spread or honey.
